DID YOU KNOW THAT ...?

- Legaris Reserva is the winery's flagship wine and has won the most awards.
- Limited production. It's only produced in very good and excellent years, when the Tempranillo grapes can be harvested very ripe. A powerful but also complex and elegant wine.
- Aged for 18 months in French oak barrels (50% new and 50% from one wine).
- Aged for a further 2 years in the bottle before being put on the market.
- Tempranillo gets its name from being a variety of grape that ripens early ("temprano" in Spanish), which is particularly important in such a late-ripening area as Ribera del Duero, where harvesting is usually carried out in the middle of October. However, in colder years Tempranillo can't reach optimum ripeness and in these cases we don't produce any Legaris Reserva.
